1. The following information on the disposal of the remaining Wessex helicopters is forwarded as requested at the Reference:

2. The disposal of the Wessex Helicopters has been approved as follows:

- a. Aircraft N7-214, N7-221, N7-222 and N7-226 to the Training Department NAS NOWRA.
- b. Aircraft N7-203 to be retained by HMAS NIRIMBA for apprentice training for Air Technical sailors.
- c. Aircraft N7-204, N7-205, N7-217, N7-223 and N7-224 to the Australian Naval Aviation Museum (awaiting Ministerial Approval).
- d. Aircraft N7-200, N7-209, N7-210, N7-218 and N7-220 to firefighting and training purposes within NAS NOWRA.

2. The remaining unique spares are to be direct issued to NAS NOWRA for use by the Air Training Department. Those spares not required by NAS NOWRA are to be disposed through the Inventory Reduction Team.
